Wondering what to give up for Lent? Forget it! That usually only lasts a couple of weeks anyway. This year, instead of GIVING UP something, let us GIVE something!! The St. Ansgar's Mission Committee would like your help in putting together Personal Care Kits as a Lenten project. Creating Personal Care Kits is a simple way to offer comfort and hope to people living in the direst situations. In 2023 St. Ansgar's, with the help of Thrivent, was able to assemble 54 kits. We're challenging you to help us exceed that number this year. We found that you can locally purchase the items needed for one kit, for under \$13. You can bring one item weekly or bring all of the items at one time, on or before Easter Sunday. Just put items into the baskets provided in the narthex near the display. Confirmation students will be helping us assemble and pack the kits. The kits will be brought to the Lutheran World Relief warehouse and then distributed worldwide. CCIC Update

The Community Churches Interaction Council is a group of Cannon Falls Churches who have come together to have a positive, gospel-centered impact on our community. During the pandemic activities were limited but the group has re-formed and has new energy. The council meets quarterly, the last meeting was on January 22.

The support for Feed My Starving Children and the Good Samaritan Fund continues to be strong, and there are many additional ministries we can come together to support. The Goodhue Habitat for Humanity is in need of volunteers. They are looking for local people with all sorts of skills: carpentry, plumbing, electric, and even quilting and cooking, to name a few. Ideally, Cannon Falls would have a team of capable volunteers ready to jump in whenever there are housing needs (even small repairs and home improvements) through the Habitat for Humanity program. The Senior Center continues to grow its programming and involvement. There are many programs we can support there including fabric donations for the Dress a Girl program. Lastly, the CCIC has agreed to better support and eventually take the lead on the Thanksgiving Community Meal again (look for more information in the fall).

When we come together, just as Jesus called us, the possibilities are endless. The CCIC is currently accepting Dream Ideas as we imagine what we can achieve for the greater good of the Cannon Falls Area. I hope you will consider getting involved in at least one of these meaningful service opportunities.






