

### A note from Pastor Tim



Dear Partners,

For years (14 to be precise), Lisa, Madeline, Bron-

wyn, and I would hitch-up our pop-up trailer and head out on a month-long adventure. always, but most years, we really didn't have a destination in mind. As a matter of fact, I can remember several times when, after fueling up at the Kwik Trip in Northfield, I would turn to Lisa and say, "Which way... north, south, east, or west?" We would pick a direction and see what could be seen. ended up in some fantastic places over the years: the maritime provinces in Canada, Idaho, New Mexico, and many other beautiful spots. There was something special about being footloose and fancy free.

St. Ansgar's? Which way, North, south, east, or west? We really cannot be nonchalant about our direction at this stage of our history. The choice of our next permanent pastor is, I believe, pivotal for our faith As I have been community. listening to members in the past eight weeks, it seems clear to many of you that St. Ansgar's is at a crossroads. What will it be? Further decline or rejuvenation? So many of you have expressed your hope that we take the time to seriously consider our options and set out in a direction that potentially will bring reinvention, redirection, and parish renewal. That is my fervent wish for us as well.

As an Intentional Interim Pastor (transitional pastor), I am dedicated to assisting you in the answer to these three questions:

Who are we?
Who is our neighbor?
What is God calling
us to be and to
do?

Toward that end I have asked for and received permission from our Church Council to lead you in a retreat in which we will develop two key tools which will assist in our call process. They are (1) developing a clear understanding of our PURPOSE (God's purpose for this faith community) and (2) a laserfocused statement of the GUID-ING PRINCIPLES that will quide us in the fulfillment of God's purpose for our congregation. These tools will assist us in developing our congregational profile (to be sent to prospective pastoral candidates), our formation and training of the Call Committee, the development of a focused list of questions that, at all times, lifts our purpose and our guiding principles, and our ultimate selection of a pastor to lead St. Ansgar's for many years to come.

The method I will use to lead the retreat is simple: prayer, scripture study, and discussion. While I can't promise that the event will be fun, I am hoping that participants will enjoy the camaraderie and meaningfulness of the work both personally and congregationally.

We will work in teams. No one will be put on the spot to answer questions. The hopes and

have for dreams you Ansgar's will be our singular focus. The morning session will answer these questions: How can we be useful to God in the realization of God's purpose and mission here in Cannon Falls and around our country and world? What is our purpose? Why do we exist? What needs to change for us to be an effective congregation for Jesus Christ? The afternoon session will focus on congregational values. Together we will discover the guiding principles (past, present, and future) that will guide our decisions moving forward. Lunch will be offered between sessions. We will start at 9:00 a.m. and end at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 6, 2021 in the Fellowship Hall here at St. Ansgar's.

I will be so happy if <u>you</u> can participate. Please register (so that we have enough information packets and food) by signing up on the poster in the Narthex or by emailing me at sapastortim@gmail.com. And I get it — sometimes plans change and new commitments arise. If you have to cancel, you can cancel. Didn't have a chance to sign up but all of a sudden have some free time on November 6? Please come!

You have much to contribute. Your congregation needs your inspirations and insights. I hope you will strongly and prayerfully consider coming.

The Adult Educational Forums are now being planned for Fall and Winter at St Ansgar's beginning October 10th!



# St. Ansgar's Library News & Updates






